Will of Raffe Adderton, husbandman of Churchill 1559

Testamentum Radulphi Adderton de Churchill

In the name of god amen the seconde daye of February in the yere of o[ur] lord god 1556 I Raffe Adderton of Churchyll in the Countie of Oxford husbandman beyng sicke of bodye but of sounde and p[er]fect memorye ordeyne and make my last wyll and testament in manor and forme following First I doo bequethe and gyve againe into the hands of my lorde god my sowle at what tyme it shall please hym of his goodnesse and mercye to call for it And I wyll my body be buryede in the church yarde of Churchyll Allso I gyve and bequethe to my sonne John Adderton a cow named crookehorne and a mattocke Item to John Hall my daughter Katherines sonne a browne heyfer All the resydue of my goodes I wyll to remayne to Christian my wyffe and Wyll[ia]m my sonne whom I make my executors These beyng witnesse Wyllyam Kyrre and Thomas Carpenter
