Will of Robert Beard, of Sarsden, 1599

In the name of god Amen The xvth. day of Aprill
in the yeare of o[ur] lorde god one thousande five
hundred ninety & nine of Robert Beard of Sarsden
in the county of oxon beinge of p[er]fecte memory doe
make my last wyll & testament in man[ner] & forme
followinge I Firste bequeath my soule into the
hands of [m]y allmighty & my body to the grounds
whe[n]soever it shall please him to call for it my
worldly goods I dispose thus I give unto Griffen
Anison the sonne of my sonne in lawe Edward
Anison one ewe & a lambe & one bullock one heyfor
of a yeare oulde I[te]m I give unto my daughter Jane
tenn pounce of lawful english money to be payed unto
her w[ith]in sixe monthes aft[er] my disseasse It[em] I give unto
Johan my wife £xx lawfull money of englande & the
one halfe of all my houshoulde stuffe and all moveable & unmove
able to be used & bestowed at her wyll & pleasure
It[em] I give unto my broth[er] George bearde one heifer
and bullock of a yeare oulde The rest of my goods
moveable & unmovable (my debts & legacies payed & my
fun[er]alls discharged) I give unto my sonne George
bearde who I doe make my whole & lawfull executor
In wyttness whereof I give hear to sett my hande this
day & yeare above wrytte[n]
