The inventory of all t<sup>he</sup> goods moveable and immoveable of William Bearde of Churchill diseased: made & praised by Richard Maunder Morrise Harvey & Tho<sup>s</sup> Bearde [th]e last of July in [th]e yeare of o[ur] Lord god one thousand five hundred foure score and nine as followeth
