Labourer do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and
form following Aft

First I give unto my Brother Thomas Borton my best great Coat
It[em] I give unto my Brother in Law Thomas White one old suite of Clothes
It[em] I give unto Frances my loving wife one black Cow and all the rest and
residue of my personal estate Goods and Chattles whatsoever and do make
her whole and sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament and
have hereunto set my hand and seal this Tenth day of March in
the year of our Lord One thousand six hundred ninty and Five
