Will of William Bridges, yeoman, of Churchill, 1658

In the name of God Amen this

eleaventh day of November in the yeare of our Lord One Thousand sixe hundred Fiftie and eight I William Bridges of Churchill in the county of Oxford yeoman beinge sicke and weake of body but of good and perfect minde and memorie (Thanks be given to Almightie God for the same) Doe make and ordayne my last will and Testament In manner and forme following (That is to say) First and especially I Commend my Soule into the hands of Almighty God my maker Not doubtinge but through the merritts of Jesus Christ his only sonne and my alone Saviour to bee made pertake of life everlastinge And as for my Body I Commend it to the earth whereof it was made and to be interred in Christian buriall att the discretion of my Execu trix hereinafter named And for such Goods and personall Estate that God hath lent mee I give and bestowe as followeth (That is to say) First I give and bequeath unto William Bridges my Eldest sonne Five shillings Alsoe I give and bequeath to Thomas Bridges my youngest sonne Five shillings Also I give and bequeath unto Amy and Elizabeth Bridges Two of my daughters Five shillings appece Also I give and bequeath unto Mary Bridges my daughter Forty pounds to bee paid unto her within Two yeares next after my decease Alsoe all therest of my goods and Chattels unbequeath/ed/ my debts beinge paid and Funerall expenses discharged I give and bequeath unto my loveinge wife Amy Whom I make constitute and ordayne Executrix of this my last will and Testa ment In Witnes whereof I the said William Bridges have hereunto put my hand and seale the day and yeare first above written Will[iam] Bridges Read sealed and published to bee my last will and Testament in the presence of W[illia]m Thomas Thomas Bridges William White

This will was proved att London the thirtieth day of Dec ember in the yeare of our Lord God One Thousand Six Hundred and Fiftie and eight: Before the Judges for probate of wills and grantinge Administrations lawfully authorized By the oath of Amy Bridges the relict and sole Executrix named in the said will To whom Administration of all and singular the goods Chatells and Debts of the said Deceased was Committed she being sworn by Commission truehe to Administer the same
