William Bryge de Churchehyll

In the name of god Am[e]n in the yere of o[ur] lord god 1530

the xth of January I Will[ia]m Bryge of the p[ar]ish of
churchyll w[i]thin the deanry of chypyngnorton sownd

to be buryd in the churchyard of al halows in

churchyll I make my executor Anne my Wyff

I bequethe to the mother church of lincoln ij^d to thehye altar iij^d to the lyghtes in the churche fyrstto alhalowes iiij^d to saynt su[n]daye iiij^d to th[e] roodelofte ij^d to o[ur] lady iiij^d to saynt cleme[n]t ij^d to sayntnicholars iiij^d to saynt ch[rist]ofer ij^d to saynt antony ij^dto the belles iiij^d alsoe I bequethe to Will[ia]m my eldy[st]

sonne my grette brasse potte & a maser bownd in

sylv[er] & gylt vj sylv[er] spones & vj^s viij^d also Anha [?] my

eld[es]t daughter a taggyd cowe a sylv[er] spone a pott

out interrupc[i]on of any man[ner] paying the renttes

& rep[ar]ac[i]on tyll my sonne come to lawfull age [my]
sonne Nicholas whose yeres be through also
I bequethe to repayre nesessaris in & on the church
aforesayde xx^s
the rest of my rentts I wyll John Bryge my brother doo receve
hit to the use of Willi[a]m my sonne & so to kepe hyt tyll he come
to lawfull age & therto he hath p[ro]myst to be bownd in Anobly -
gac[i]on of xx^{ti}L then to make deliv[er]anttes therof and all
my goodes nott bequetheyd I gyve to Anne my wyffe seyng
my body bro[u]ght onestly in erthe & my monythys mynd
kept monythly tyll the yere be past record berer to Sir Robert
Bytthyn vycar Will[ia]m Gyvys John cowlste A Cho[?]s
[?]yssye Thomas bryge w[i]th Dyv[er]s other
