Will of Ales Carpenter, of Churchill, 1597

Anno d[o]mi[ni] 1599 xxviiijth die

October

In the name of god Amen I Ales Carpenter of Churchill in the countie of Oxon widowe beinge sicke in bodie but of good and p[er]fect remembrance (thankes be to god) doe make this my last will and testament in manner and forme followinge
First I bequeathe my soule to almightie god and my bodie to be buried in the churchyard of Churchill aforesaide
It[em] I give and bequeathe unto Isobell my daughter my hanginge kete one linen turne a posnet the better candlesticke the great cofor the bed I nowe lye on withe all the furniture be thereunto belonginge, (exceptinge the twille clothe) ij bushells of wheate one bushell of barleye one bushell of pulse to be delivered at harvest next cominge my best table clothe my christeinge sheete and my curtaine whiche sheetes and curtaine my will is that my other children shall have them to use when they shall have neede thereof It[em] I geve unto Joane my daughter one cove one pott one little kete one candlesticke ij best platters one paire of sheetes ij bushells of wheat ij bushells of barleye the one halfe to be paide this yeare the other halfe the next yeare & the seconde table clothe It[em] I geve unto margaret my daughter one calfe to be wintered and delivered her at maie daie next ij platters the next beste one bushell of wheate one bushell of barleye to be delivered with in one monthe after my decease my best gowne my hat and my medlie apporne It[em] I geve unto Ales my daughter one bushell of barleye to be delivered at harvest next. It[em] I geve unto Joane

my daughter one linen turne my best peaticote and
a round kyver. It[em] I geve unto Ellin plucke one bushell
of wheate to be delivered at harvest next It[em] I geve
unto Anne Clivleye one twille clothe ij peeces of
pewter one chaffron and my ruffle gowne It[em] I geve
Unto Jhon Serche one bushell of wheate and one bushell
of barleye to be delivered at harvest cominge at twelve
monthe the rest of all my goodes not geven
I geve and bequeathe unto Jhon Carpenter my
sonne whom I make my whole and sole executor
