Memorand that John Cowling of Churchill in the County and Diocese of Oxon whoe deaparted the life in November laste att about 6 weeke before hee dyed being then sick of the sickness wh[er]eof hee dyed lying on his sickbedd in a lower roome of his dwelling howse having an intencon to dispose of his goods and effate did in the p[re]sence of the Witnesses underwritten latter and declare these words following or the like in effort First hee did give and bequeath all his goods to Catherine his wife hee being then in p[er]fect sense memory and Understanding
