Will of Nicholas Everton, of Churchill, 1555

Testamentum Nicholas Everton de Churchyll

In the name of God amen the vth daye of October in the yere of our lorde god 1554. I Nicolas Everton of Churchyll beyng sicke in bodye and sounde in mynde make this my laste wyll or Testamente in maner and forme followinge First I bequeth my sowle to allmyghtie god to [th]e ladie saynte Marie and to all the omni in heaven and my bodye to be buried in the churche yarde of the parishye churche of Churchyll It[e]m I bequeathe to the belles of [th]e churche of Churchyll xiij^d It[e]m I bequeathe to Alice Cooles my bedd whereupon I nowe doo lye with coveringe two bolsters and fyve paire of shetes to be delyved to the said Alyce at suche tyme as she shalbe of the age of xvij yeres by Katherine my dawghter[s] mother to the saide Alice And if it shall fortune (as god bydd) that the said Alice do depte awlo this worlde afore her tyme aforesaide then I wyll the legacies aforesaide equally to be distributed betwyxte her two brotheres and to the longer lyver of them Allso I gyve to the said Alice a moorterpanne and a potte two boards a broche one cow Allso I gyve to Nicholas Cooles one potte with a kettoll one cowe a cople of harrowes It[e]m I gyve to John Cooles one cowe and a heifer and eyght sheepe Allso I gyve Nicolas Cooles aforesaid viij shepe Allso the rest of my sheepe remayninge Unbequeathed I gyve to Florence Gardiner Allso I gyve Jone bolde one bussell of malte Allso I gyve to Joane Tarrsser one bussell of malte and the reste of my goodes not bequeathed I gyve to Richarde Gardyner and Katherine his wyffe whom I make executors of this my presente Testamente and laste Wull and John Cooles and Richarde Lucas overseeres of the same Those beyng Wytnesse George Pottes John Brydges Wylliam Badger Wyllya[m] Berde Richarde Trusser with others
