Will of Mary Hacker, widow, of Churchill, 1701

In the name of god Amen The eleventh day of November
Anno d[omi]ni 1699 I Mary Hacker of Churchill in the
County of Oxon Widdow being ancient & weak in body
but of perfect memory pra'sed be God for it And
calling to remembrance the uncertainty of this life
on earth & that all flesh must yeild to death when it
shall please god to call doe make this my last Will
& Testam[en]t in the manner following first I commit my
soull into the hands of almighty god my only Saviour
& redeemer trusting in him to receive full pardon
& forgivenessse of all my sinns & my body to the earth
from whence it was taken to be buryed in such
decent & christian like manner as my Executor here
after named shall think meet & convenient And as
to such goods & Chattles as the Lord in his mercy
hath lent me I give & dispose as followeth
Impr[im]is my Will & pleasure is that my debts & Legacys &
funerall expences be discharged.

Item I give & devise unto my son Thomas Hacker
one shilling

Item I give & devise unto my son William Hacker the
Sum[m]e of five pounds to be paid to him within the
space of Two years next after my decease

Item I give and devise unto my daughter ^{Ann} the Wife of Robert
Allen the sum[m]e of Tenn shillings to be paid to her
w[i]thin the space of one year after my decease

It[e]m I give & device unto my daughter Elizabeth the Wife
of Thomas Lorde the sum[m]e of Tenn shillings to be paid
to her w[i]thin the space^{of} one year after my decease

Item I give & devise unto my daughter Alice the wife of
George Savage the sum[m]e of Tenn shillings to be
paid to her w[i]thin the space of one year after my decease

Item I give & devise unto my son George Hacker & to
my daughter Mary Hacker all my household goods
whatsoever betweene them equally to be
devided

Item I give & devise unto my f[orsai]d sonn George Hacker
all the rest of my goods & Chattles whatsoever
upon Condition that he shall pay all my reall
Debts & Legacys & bear the charge of my funeral
expences And Doe alsoe hereby make him my
sole & whole Executor of this my last Will
& Testam[en]t Revoking all other Wills & Testam[en]ts
