Will of Edward Hall, of Sarsden, 1548

Testamentum Edward Hall de Sarsden

In the name of god amen the xxiiijth daye of September In the yere of our Lorde god A thowsand fyve hundred fortie eight I Edwarde Hall of Sarsden sycke in bodie and sounde in mynde make my wylle & Testament in maner folowinge Firste I bequeth my sowle to allmyghtie god and my bodie to be buryed in the churche yarde of the paryshe churche of Churchyll It[e]m I bequeth to John Hall my sonne one Heyfar one shepe and halfe an acre of barleye It[e]m to Marie my dawghter one cowe one halfe an acre barley It[e]m to Elsa[beth] Hall my dawghter one heyfer and halfe an acre barley And the rest of my goodes not bequeathed I gyve to Elizab[eth] my wyffe whome I make hole executrix of thys my presente Wylle These beyng Wytnesse S[ir] Arthure Dyxe Symon Harris & Wyllyam Olde[?] with other
