In the name of god Amen in the yere of o[ur] Lorde god a thowsande  
fyve hundred fortie Syx I John Harres of the paryshe of Churchyll  
beyng hole of mynde and sycke in bodye make this my Testament first  
I bequeath my sowle to allmightie god and my body to be buried in the  
churtyard of all Saynts in Churchyll It[e]m I bequeath to the mother  
churche of Oxon ij<sup>d</sup> It[e]m to the high alter of Churchyll iiij<sup>d</sup> to the  
torces & belles viij<sup>d</sup> It[e]m I bequeath to the [illegible] my beste  
cote or v<sup>s</sup> in money and all my goodes [illegible] I gyve And  
bequeth to Jone my wyffe And to Wyllyam my sonn in Law John whom  
I make my hole executors and if anye of them mysse [?] or [?]  
hym [?] age [?] they to be ordered by my overseers of [?]  
this my Wyll [?] and John Casells ???  
tappan and sawke ? Darset ? with dyvers other
