Will of Thomas Harris, of Sarsden, yeoman, 1639

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Harris of
Sarden in the County of oxon yeoman being sicke in
body but of p[er]fecte memorie thankes bee given to god doe
make my Last will and testamentin manner and forme as
followeth the eightenth day of may An[n]o Dom[ini] 1639 first
I comend my soule unto the hands of allmightie god my
maker and redemer hopinge to bee saved by the merittes
of Jesus C[hri]ste and my bodie to bee buried in the pisheris
Churche yarde of Churchill
