

Oxford History Centre MS Wills Oxon 29/4/69**Will of Peter Harvie, of Churchill, 1608**

In the name of god amen; I Peeter Harvie Churchhill in the countie of oxford taylor being sicke in bodie but of good & perfect remembrance god I give him prayse for it; doe make this my laste will & testament the twelwe daye of December in the yeere of our Lord god one thousand six hundred and seaven; in man[n]e^r and forme following; first I Doe com[m]itt my soule to allmightie god and my bodie to the grounde to be buried in the Church-yard of Churchill in aforesayde ; Ite[m] I doe give unto my wife ^{Alis} and to my three children my son[n]e & two Daughters; all suche som[m]es of monye, which are Due to ^{me} by any; eyther by bondes or othe^r writings & all other which shall be Due unto me by any fo^r woorke or ^{by} other meanes Lent; the same when it ^{is} Demanded and gathered upp of these that Doe owe it, ^{unto me} equally to be Devided betwixte them by given Portions; Item I give unto them in Like ^{maner} to be Devided betwixt ^{them} these fewe sheepe which ^{now} I have; Item I give unto my mother xx^s The rest of ^{all} my goodes & catle, ^{my Debts being payde} I Give unto my ^{Alis} wife towardses the norrishing of my poore children; also I Doe make ^{Alis} my wife my whole executor; Likewise I shall Desire my uncle thomas mullington & my cossen ^{William} mullington to see this my Will ^{fullye} fulfilled and kept;
