Will of Francis Haselwood, Churchill, 1650

In the name of God Amen The Nyne and twentieth Day of January
in the yeare of our Lord God One Thousand six hundred forty & nyne I
Francis Haselwood of Sarsden in the Countie of Oxon beinge (god be
praised) of perfect memory although sicke in body Doe make & ordaine this
my last Will and Testament in manner and forme as followeth first I
bequeathe my Soule to Almighty god hoping by the merritts and Death of Jesus
Christ only to receive remission for all my Sins and my body to the earth when
it shall please god to call for it And for all my worldley goods I dispose of
them as followeth
my Will is and I Doe Desire that my debts beinge payd and my funerall expenses
discharged that all the rest of my goods may be divided amongst my eight
children namely Thomas Haselwood William Haselwood Francis Haselwood
Edmund Haselwood John Haselwood Anne Haselwood Edithe Haselwood only
except my Daughter Mary Haselwood to whome I give a Double portion whome
I doe make [my H] the Executor of this my Will and Testament
And I doe desire my worthy and loving Frends William Bridges of Churchill
my brother in law John Harris and my Brother Thomas Harris & John Rawlins
of Sarsden to be the Overseers in Trust of this my last will and for their
Care and paynes herein I give unto each of them Twelve pence
And likewise my Desire and Will is that the forenamed Overseers shall have
power to receive all such Stocks & goods as shall arise amongst my children out
of the said goods----- to be payed by them

to them for the best benefitt of my children and the sayd stocks &
goods to be delivered unto my sayd children at such time as my fore
named friends shall think fitt and requisite

And allso my Will and Desire is that if any of my sayd children shall dye
before they shall receive their parte of my goods that then my Overseers
shall despose of the same amongst the rest of my children at their discretions
as they shall thinke fitte
