D of G of Elizabeth Hyett, of Sarsden, 1628

Be it known to all men by these pu[blish]eth I Elizabeth hyett of Sarsden in the countie of Oxon spinster for the naturall love of and affection that I beare to my kinsman John Bennett of Chipping Norton Labourer and also for that the same John Bennett is contented and agreed to receive me into his house and to provide for me and allowe unto me meat, drinkes houseroome, apparrell washing and bodyinge meete and convenient for a woman of my degree and callinge for and duringe the w[h]ole life of him the said John Bennett and for other good considracens mee movinge doe hereby give and gr[ant] unto him the said John Bennett his excutors and assignes all my goods what soever moveable and unmoveable stocke of mon[e]y and houshold stuffe w[hi]ch I either have in possession or unto ande in any waye belongeth and In witnesse whereof I have caused this deede of gift irrevokeably to bee made and have hereto sett my hand and seale the 23rd day of Aprill In the thirde yeare of the Reigne of our Sovrigne Lord Charles kinge of England Scotland France & Ireland Defender of the Faith etc.
