An inventorie of the goodes of Friswide Medcrafte of Churchill
in the County of oxon deceased prised and valued by Anthony
Crosse and John Harvey the xxij day of Februarie 1636
as followethe

Imp[ri]mis her apparell and the money in her purse	twenty shillinge
It[em] her brasse and pewter	twenty sixe shilling and eight pence
It[em] her bedhealing and other woollinge cloathes belonging to her bed	twenty shillinge
It[em] her sheetes and other linninge	twenty shillinges
It[em] her hay	three shillinge fowre pence
It[em] her bedsteed and one coffer and other impements	ten shillinges
It[em] her corne	six shillinges eight pence
It[em] her featherbed	ten shillinge
