In the name of god Amen The xxth day of March in the ye[a]re of o[ur] lord god 1558 I Peter Minchin of the p[a]rish of Churchill beyng Sicke in bodie & of p[er]fit r[e]membrance doe make th[i]s will & testament in man[ne]r & forme Following First First I doe bequeathe my soule unto almyghtie god & my bodie to be buried in the church yard Also to the mother church of Oxon ijs Also to William my sonne a verlynge callffe at holyroode day come xii monthe & another ca[11]ffe at holyroode day come ij yeres Also I bequeathe to my daughter Joane as my sonne William hathe & besides to have an ewe & a lame Also to my daughter Katheryne Alice ij verelynge calves nyne vere to come and an ewe & lame Also to Katheryne my daughter ij yerelynge callfes an ewe & a lame viij yeres to come Also to Elizab[e]th my daughter ij yerelynge callves and a ewe & a lame tene yeres to come Also to Richard my sonne ij yerelynge callevs an one ewe & a lame xij yeres to come Also to John my sonne ij yerelynge callves an ewe and a lame every x^{ten} yeres to come Also to George my Co[sin]? ij yerelynge callves and one ewe & lame xiij yeres to come and if it shall please god to call for eny of the foresaid children to his mercie then it is my will the foresaide goods shall remayne to the longest lyver Also to the High aulter ij^s also I make & ordayne Joane

my wyffe my executrix of all my goods mov eable & immoveable unbequeathed there beying ov[er]sears Richard Caler & Thomas Minchen recorders of the same will S[i]r Humfrey Bower John Jeves John Bryges Morice Molyngton Richard Mawnder
