Will of Thomas Minchin, of Churchill, 1583

In the name of god ameⁿ I Thomas minchin of Churchill in the countie of Oxon Beingie sicke in bodie neverthelesse of good and p[er]fect rememberance (god for the same be praised) doe make ordaine and constitute this my last will and testa=ment in manner and forme followinge First I bequeathe my soule to allmightie god my maker and redemer and my bodie to the grounde from whence it was take[n] to be buried in the churcheyard of Churchill aforsaide It[em] I give and bequeathe unto Wyll[ia]m my sonn[e] five sheepe a malt miline a coffer one table bord one sestyn one benche a garner for corne a pair of dounge droaghts a [illegible] and a coulter ij aple trees one bedsteed one payre of sheetes one twillye clothe one bolster ij pewter platters the better brasse pott and one coifer all the which my will is shalbe delivered wythin one moneth after my decease It[em] I give to Anne my daughter iiij ewes one feather bed whiche bed to be delivered after my decease & my wives one cubbord one boulster one chest one payre of sheetes ij towells one bedsteed one pott one belte one cartaine ij pewter platters one candlestick & one chafinge dyshe of brasse It[em] I give unto Ales my daughter ij bushells of wheat ij bushells of barley one sheepe and to her two children michael and Emennell ether of them a sheepe It[em] I give unto Anne my daughter one posnet and to her sonne Thomas one sheepe The rest of all my goodes not geve[n] I geve and bequeath unto Elisbeth my wife whom I doe make my whole
