Will of Thomas Minchin, husbandman, of Churchill, 1669

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Minchin of Churchill
in the County of Oxon husbandman being Sicke
in body but of p[er]fect memorie thanks be given to
god for the saime Doe make & ordayne this my last
will & testam[en]t the Sixteenth Day of Aprill An[n]o D[o]m[ini]
1667 And in the nineteenth yeare of the raigne of
o[u]r Sov[er]aigne Lord Charles the Second by the grace of god
of England Scotland France & Ireland being Defender
of the faith ? in manner & forme as followeth First
I Com[m]itt my Soule into the hands of Almighty god hoping
to be Saved by the passion of Jesus Christ & my bodie to be
buried in the Churchyard of the Parish Church of Churchill
aforesaid And of my Worldly goods I thus Despose of them
as followeth Impr[i]mis I give to the poore of Churchill aforesaid
twenty shillings of Lawfull money of England to be Distributed
amongst them p[re]sently after my decease Item I give &
bequeath unto Robert Buntinge the Son of my kinsman
Robert Buntinge of Risington pla in the County Glouc[ester]
the Su[m]me of Five pounds of Lawfull money of England to be paid
w[i]thin one yeare next after my Decease Item I give & bequeath
unto my kinsman Thomas Minchin of Longborough in the
County of Glouc[ester] The Su[m]me of five pounds of Lawfull money of

England to be paid unto him w[i]thin one yeare next after my
Decease Item I give & bequeath unto my kinswoman Anne
Minchin of Chipping Norton the Daughter of Thomas Minchin
of the same towne Deceased w[hi]ch said Daughter hee had by
his first wife the Su[m]me of Tenn Shillings to be payd unto her w[i]thin
one yeare next after my Decease Item I give & unto Anne Lucas
the Daughter of Richard Lucas one ioyne bedsteede over the butterie
Item I give unto Alice Lucas Daughter of the said Richard one
ioyne bedsteede in the Chamber next the butterie my wife Elizabeth
to have the use of the bedsteede as longe as shee liveth Item I Doe
appoint & ordayne my beloved wife Elizabeth my sole executrix
& to be my executrix of this my last will & testament In wittnes
whereof I have Sett my hand & Seale this my last will & testament the
day & year above written
