Will of William Minchin, of Churchill, 1598

In the name of god Ame[n] the xiiith daye of maie 1598 I will[ia]m Minchin of Churchill in the countie of Oxon husbandma[n] doe make this my last will & testamentin manner and forme followinge

First I give nad bequethe my soule unto Jesus Christ my onelye saviour & redeemer by whose merits deathe and passion I hope to inheritt the Kingdome of heaven

It[em] I geve and bequeathe unto Peter minchin my sonne vii^l It[em] unto Jo. minchin my sonne vii^l It[em] unto Tho[mas] minchin my sonne v^l It[em] I geve unto Elisabeth my daughter vj^l

It[em] unto Anne my daughter iiij^l It[em] unto Emma my daughter iiij^l It[em] unto my daughter Marie iiij^l It[em] my will is that my saide sonnes shall have their saide portions unto

them geven when they shall accomlishe the age of xxiiij^{tie} yeares: and my saide daughters to have their saide portions when they shall accomlishe the age of xxj^{tie} yeares

or at the daie of their marriages whiche hit shall please god first to happen And further my Will is that if hit

shall please god that anie of my Children shall depart this life; before they shall accomplish the ages and yeares before saide that then their saide portions shall remaine

& be equallie divided amongst the rest whiche shalbe then livinge; The residue of all my goodes and cat

tells moveable & immoveable I geve and bequeathe unto Elisabethe my wife whom I doe make my sole executrix my debt legacies & funeralls discharged It[em] I doe make my brother Richard Mathewe my overseer

It[em] I doe owe unto my Richard
minchin my brother xxi^s
