In The Name of God Amen . This fourteenth day of April
in the yeare of our Lord god One Thousand Six
hundred Ninty and ^{one} I Walter Norton of Churchill
in the County of Oxon Waver being p[er]fect in
minde and Memory thanks be given to allmighty
god do make and ordaine this my last will &
Testament in Maner and fome following
Viz. First and principaly . I Comend my Soule
into the hands of Allmighty god my maker
and Jesus Christ my Redeemer and as
for the Estate wch it hath pleased god to
bestow upon me I dispose there of as follow
=eth IP I will that my debts and funeral
Charges shall be paid and . discharged
I Give and bequeathe to my daughter Mary
Harrod¹ My house and Cowes Com[m]on and the
fewell in the heath after the decease
of my wife allso one Coverlid w^{ch} is the
best and the Cupboard in the hall after
the decease of my wife . It[em] I give &
bequath to Jonathon Bowle² the some
of five shillings to be paid by my daught[er]
Mary wth in Six months after the decea^{se}
of my wife It[e]m It[e]m I do make my wife
Mary Norton full and Sole executrix of this
my last will and Testement Revokeing
all other wills by Me heretofor: made
