Will of Ellin Perse, widow, of Churchill, 1593

Test[ementu]m Elinore Perse de Churchyll

In the name of god Ame[n] In the yeare of our lord god 1593
and the xxijth daye of September I Ellin Perse of
Churchill in the Countie of Oxon Widowe beinge sicke
in bodie but of good and p[er]fect remembrance (God for the
same be praised) Doe make this my last will and testa –
ment in manner and forme following first I bequeathe
my soule to almyghtye god my maker and redeemer and
my bodie to the grounde from whence hit was taken
It[em] I geve unto Robert Perse my sonne ij kyne going
in the leasowes one wythe a white face and an other
called bull head to be delivered the first of Maie next
insuinge and followinge ij platters ij pottingers ij
sausors and ij Upstendes It[em] I geve unto Pyter Perse
my sonne one yeard land croppe to be delivered
at harvest next the great blacke cowe iij payre of
sheetes one blanket one bed healinge of white and
redd coloures iij platters iij sausers the lesser pott
the best boulster and the newe bedsteede It[em] I geve
unto Elisabethe my daughter ij stalls of bees my
[b]est hatt my best gowne my best petticoat my
[b]est wast coate and one smocke and to eache of
her iij children vj^d Thomas, Robert and Anne
one stall of Bees to be delivered at Christmas next
It[em] I geve unto Pyter Perse my sonne his
[w]ife ij kerchaffes and one smocke It[em] I geve unto
Jhon Sessions Jun[ior] one bushell of wheate The use
[o]f All my goodes not given I geve and bequeathe

unto Henrie Perse my sonne whom I doe make
my whole and lawfull Executor to see this my last
will and testament fully p[er]formed and kept
