Will of Robert Prise, yeoman, of Churchill, 1683

In the Name of God Amen of Robert Prise of Churchill
in the County of Oxon yeoman being Weake in body
But of perfect mind and memory Doe make this my
Last Will and Testament in manner Followeing
First I commit my Soule into the hands of Almighty
God my Maker hoping and assuredly trusting to be
Saved by the [alone][*crossed out*] Merritts of my onely Lord &
Blessed Saviour Jesus Christ And not for any
good That is in me And my body I commit to
the Earth from whence it was taken to be
decently buried At the Discretion of my Executor
hereafter Named And for my Temporall Estate
which it hath pleased Almighty God to blesse me
w[ith] all I Dispose of And doe Give & bequeath
the same unto my beloved kinsman Roger
Medcroft the elder of Churchill aforesaid yeoman
For to provide for me during my naturall life
sufficient diett washing& Lodging And Likewise
when it shall please Allmighty God to take me out
of this World to Decently to interre my body which
afforesaid kinsman Roger Medcroft The elder
I Doe make my full & whole Executor Revoking
all former & other wills In Witness whereof
I have hereunto sett my hand & seale this
Third Day of February Anno Domi[ni]1683
