Will of Marian Samson, Widow, of Sarsden, 1589

In the name of god Amen I Marian Samsone of sarsden in the cou[n]tye of oxford wydow doe make my laste Will and testament in manar & forme folowinge & First I com[m]end my sowle unto allmightye god my only maker my Re[dee]mer & savior in whom only I hope to reste for ev[er] And for this frayle & trancitory goodes [tha]t god of his great mercie hathe lente me I geve & bequethe as followith It[e]m I geve & bequethe to Jone coles my daughter j pige one pear of shetes and two shepe one pottenger and one lande of barlye It[em] to Eliez[beth] here daughter on[e] shepe It[em] to Uychara Wyckins j shepe It[em] to thomas E[?]den j shepe It[em] to his sister one sheepe It[em] to Elyzabeth Stiles my Dawghter a pear of sheetes ij shepe one platter and one pote one pigge one lande of barlye It[em] to margreat bagge my dawghter one pear of shetees one heyfor and ij shepe on[e] pige one kettell one land of barlye It[em] to Urselye <sup>Hyett</sup> one pear of sheetes one table clothe and one towell on[e] of my best platters and on[e] of my best pottingers on[e] bras pote on[e] cowe one land of barlye and ij shepe It[em] to angis bagge one peare of sheetes a table cloth a towel one of my beste platters one of my best pottingers a brase pote one cowe ij sheppe one land of barlye It[em] to James Ivoe iiij shepe one cowe and xx<sup>s</sup> of money & one shute of new aperrill It[em] to Rychard Sansome my sone a Worte pane a peare of sheetes a platter iiij shepe on[e] plowe and plowe geares one cowe and a pote one aker of barlye one pear of harrowes & also the hovell postes one pige It[em] to Nicoles Sansome j shepe the table bord in the hall Wyth the be[n]ch and forme It[em] to the poor in Sarsden every house iiij<sup>d</sup> alsoe all the reste of my goodes unbequethed paying my dettes and ~~lega~~lagaces I geeve to Edmund Sansome <sup>my sone</sup> Whom I make my sole executor truly to paye my dettes and

legaces made & p[er]fetly Rede in the Sight and p[re]sens off
