Will of Thomas Shurlie [Sen], husbandman, of Churchill, 1661

In the name of God Amen, I Thomas Shurlie of Churchill the elder in the Countie of Oxon husbandman, being in perfite health and memorie thanks be given unto Allmightie God, The seaven teenthe Daye of July in the Twelwe yeare of the Rainge of our Soveraine ^{Lord} Kinge Charles the Second in the yeare of our Lord God One thousand Six hundred and Sixtie, do make and ordaine this my last will and Testament, in mane^r and forme followinge
Impris I giove and bequeath my Soule unto Almighty God my Maker wi^[th] home I hope to have eternall reste by the merits of Christe Jesus my redeemer: and my bodie to be buried within the Churchyard w^{it}hin the parish of Churchill, At the Charge of my executor
Item I give and bequeath unto William Shurlie my Second Sonn the Sum of three pounds and tenn Shillings of lawfull english money to be paid unto him w^{it}hin one yeare nexte comminge after my desease , Item I give nad bequeath unto Robert Shurlye my youngest Sonn the Sum of three pounds & ten Shillings of good and lawfull english money to be paid unto him w^{it}hin one yeare nexte Comminge after my Desease Item I give and bequeath unto Marie Shurlie my youngest Daughter the sum of three pounds of good and Lawfull english money ^{to be paid} w^{it}hin one yeare nexte cominge after my Desease, Item I give and bequeath unto Jane Shurlie the sum of Tewntie Shillings of lawfull english money to be paid w^{it}hin one yeare nexte cominge after my Desease, Item I give and bequeath unto my [fin] Sunn ^{Thomas Shurlie} my Daughter Elizabeth hir Sonn the Sum of Fower pounds of good and lawfull english money to be paid w^{it}hin one yeare nexte comminge after my Desease but if it shall hapen that anie of my Said Childderen Doe Die or kinsman Die before the time is expired that thaye are to paue their legasises given by me then my will is that ^{the} legasie Shall remaine unto my other Childderen

equallie Devided between them Item I give and bequeath unto Thomas Shurlie my sonn Thomas his sonn the sum of twentie Shillings to be Paid as aforesaid, Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Thape hir fower Chillderen each of them twentie Shillings to be paid wⁱthin one yeare nexte comminge after my Desease, And for all the reste of my goods Moveable or Unmoveable I give and bequeath unto my sonnin lawe Robert Thape one pound I make and apiount my full and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament: And doe appounte my brother Robert Shurlie and William Sessions to be overseeres of this mt last will and testam^[ent] In witness here of I have set my habd and seale the daye and yeare above writen:
