Will of Joan Yvye, widdowe, of Sarsden, 1548

Testamentum of Joanne Yvye de Sarsden

In the name of god Amen In the yere of our lord god [rest of line illegible]
daye of Julye I Jone Yvye wedowe late wyfe to Wylliam Yvye husbandman
of the paryshe of Sarsden within the countie of oxforde thowe sycke in bodie and hole
of memorye after this maner and forme folowinge doo make my laste wyll I first
and formost I doo bequeth my sowle unto allmyghtie god and my bodie to be buryed within
the paryshe church yarde of Churchyll Allso ij^d to my mother church in Oxford Allso
all my raymente I doo bequeth to my dawghter Alice Yvyng And to my dawghter
Anne Yvinge all my raymente to be dep[ar]ted unto them equally and my sone Roberte
Yvinge and my two dawghters to have all my other goodes moveable and immoveable
to be dep[ar]ted eqally amonge them And If they doo dye then the goodes to be dep[ar]ted to the
nexte of the Kynne And Allso I wyll that Griffyn Samson be my hole executor
and overseer of this my presente Wyll after the good reason and p[er]fet discession
as god wyll gyve to hym grace these named folowinge bearynge wytnesse
Sir Arthure Dyxe my goostley father Wylliam Slye the paryshe clerke Elsa[be]th
Langbory my keper with other moo Dettes which I doo owe First to John Andrews

xj^d It[e]m to John Richardes ix^s It[e]m to John Lytherlande xij^d To John Richyns
